Christodoulos Panayiotou

If tomorrow never comes

1 November – 24 December 2008

As the first parallel exhibition to a solo exhibition in the large space, we are pleased to show the Cypriote artists Christodoulos Panayiotou (*1978) with the slide installation "If tomorrow never comes", 2007

Christodoulos Panayiotou's works emphasise mostly on sociological rituals of every-day-life and the sub textual wishs and codes they represent.

His videoworks, performances and installations reveal iconographies and mechanisms of human longing for togetherness and lastingness which lies in many pop-cultural and folkloristic contexts.

"If tomorrow never comes" is based on archive material of two daily papers in Naples, Italy where papers continued to print images in black and white still today. They show fireworks in Naples since the beginning of the 20th century until today. The repetitive images can be read as an anti-chronically anthropology of an unchanged reality, which cannot be classified historically, as if the city had rejected any temporality. In which the assumed timeliness of a message, a context or an image cannot be distinguished from the past.

At the same time the signification of fireworks in Naples is momentous in it's local context: while fireworks in Naples are used for celebrations and festivities they also serve as communication between the Camorra.

This ambivalence in the legibility of a ritualised, theatrical gesture which has lost it's temporality and could signify both suffering as well as joy is thought as a vague reference in content to Tanja Roscic's work.
